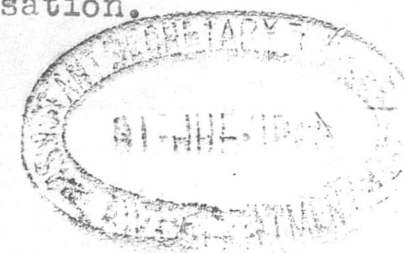

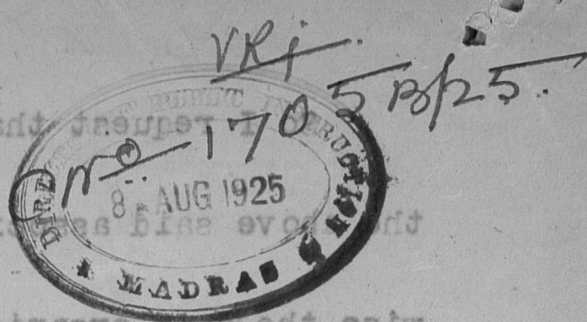

It has since been ascertained that the President, District Educational Council, Ganjam wants the approval of Government for the Teacher-managers' association now formed in his district and also representation for them on the Council-Vide copy of his -- letter R.C. 24/25 dated the 3rd October 1925 enclosed-. From
- (F) the G.Os. 1551 Law (Education), dated the 3rd November 1923 and
 - (E) 175 Law (Education), dated the 5th February 1924 it is observed that no separate recognition by Government in regard to the formation of such associations appears necessary. As regards their representation on the Council, I beg to point out that similar requests from other District Educational Councils have
 - (B) been refused in G.Os. 1536 Mis. Law (Education), dated 2nd
 - (D) October 1924 and 1408 Mis. Law (Education), dated the 1st September 1924. The reasons adduced in these G.Os. may not now be operative.
3. The District Educational Officer, Ganjam reports that there is not a well-organised District association, but only range associations have been formed.
