Messrs H. Venugopalanaidu and K. Venkatasasthrulu Naidu -
Lower subordinates - appointment to the permanent upper sub-
ordinate establishment - exemption from passing the upper
subordinate test of the College of Engineering.

Under para 7 of G.O. No. 853 W, dated the 6th September 1922, specially selected Lower subordinates are eligible for promotion to the permanent Upper Subordinate Establishment at the rate of at least one every year. In accordance with these orders, such promotions of Lower Subordinates have been made to the end of 1923. It is now proposed to make two appointments of Lower subordinates as permanent supervisors one for 1924 and the other for 1925, and Messrs H. Venugopala Naidu, overseer, Waltair Circle, and K. Venkatasasthrulu Naidu overseer, Bezwada Circle, have been selected by me. As, under para 3(H)(2) of the Public Service Notification Rules, only upper subordinate diplomates of the College of Engineering, Madras, are eligible for appointment as upper subordinates in this department, I request that the sanction of Government may be obtained to the exemption of the above mentioned two Lower subordinates from passing the upper subordinate
