Sir,

I have the honour to state that tailoring is reported to have been introduced during the year 1924-25 in the school department of the Municipal College, Salem, and that 33 pupils belonging to Forms III to VI received instruction in that subject.

2. During the current year 39 pupils are said to be receiving instruction in 6 batches, the number of hours during which the pupils of Forms III to VI receive instruction in the subject varying from 1 hour 40 minutes to 3 hours 40 minutes.

3. The Advisor to Government on Manual and Vocational Training who was consulted reports that the class is practical and useful and that the application of the Chairman for a grant towards the upkeep of the class may be favourably considered.

4. He estimates the recurring and non-recurring expenses of the class during the current year at Rs. 510 and Rs. 200 respectively as per details given in the margin.

scheme be sanctioned during the current year and that a half grant of Rs. 355 (Rs. 100 for non-recurring and Rs. 255 for recurring) be sanctioned as grant to the Municipal Council towards the expenses of the class during the current year,

the recurring expenditure of Rs. 255 being met from the sum of Rs. 15,800 and the non-recurring cost of Rs. 100 from the sum of Rs. 9,500 provided under "31 B(c) Education)-Secondary grants to Local bodies for Secondary education - grants in-aid Educational Recurring and miscellaneous non-recurring manual training in the Budget estimate for the current year.

The D.P.I. reports that a manual training class in tailoring was opened in the school dept. of the Municipal College, Salem during 1924-25 and that 33 students of forms III to VI received instruction in the subject during that year.

In the current year 39 pupils are receiving instruction in the class. The Advisor to Govt on Manual Training estimates the recurring and non-recurring charges of the class for the 1925-26 at Rs. 510 and Rs. 200 respectively.

The D.P.I. recommends that a grant subsidy of one half of the cost, Rs. 355 may be sanctioned ^{in the current year} to the Municipal Council towards the charges of the class for the current year 1925-26.
