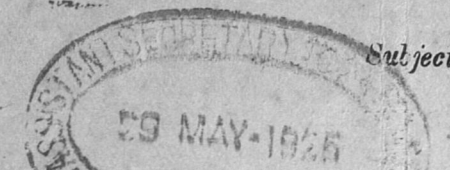

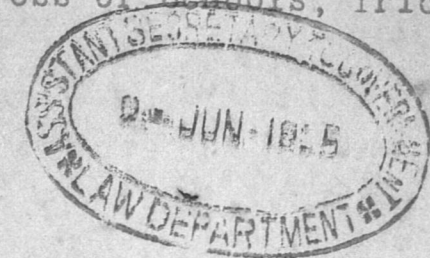

Ever since the reorganization of the Inspecting Staff and the consequent abolition of the post of the Assistant Inspector of schools, the Ex-officio seat in the District Educational Council allotted to the Assistant Inspector of schools under Section 5(3) of the Madras Elementary Education Act of 1920 remains vacant.

2. In addition, the nominated seat allotted to the Inspectress of schools in G.O.No.365 Home (Education) dated 12th. March 1921 constantly falls vacant owing to the

frequent transfers of the Inspectress of schools and consequent changes in the personnel. Further the Inspectress of schools, as she has jurisdiction over several Districts does not regularly attend the meetings of the Council.

3. In order to obviate the above non-representation of the Female Educational Officers, I suggest the -- following:-

The Ex-officio seat reserved for the Assistant Inspector of schools may be filled up by the Inspectress of schools and the nominated seat reserved for the -- latter may be filled up by the Sub Assistant Inspectress of Girls' schools whose jurisdiction is confined to a single District and who will be more useful to the -- Council being in close touch with the Girls' schools in the District.

4. I therefore request that you will be so good as to modify the Government Order No.365 Home(Education) dated 12th.March 1921 and to distribute the seats as suggested supra. (R)

5. If the amendment of the Act itself is considered necessary to transfer the seat allotted to the Assistant Inspector of schools to the Inspectress of Schools early orders may be passed at least to transfer the seat allotted to the Inspectress of schools to the Sub Assistant Inspectress of schools and the present Sub Assistant Inspectress Miss.Mc.Mannes may be appointed in place of the Inspectress of schools, whose seat is vacant--Vide also this office R.C. No. 34 of 25 dated 3rd.February 1925 and the orders of the

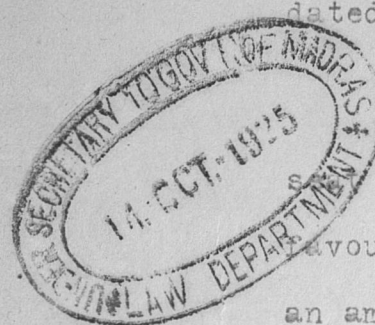
