With reference to G.O.No.1870 Law (Education)
dated 27-11-24 sanctioning the continuance up to 31-3-26
of the class opened in the Teachers' College, Saidapet, for
training instructors in Vocational subjects based on drawing
and the establishment sanctioned therefor, I have the honour
to state that the Adviser to Government on Manual & Voca-
tional Training reports that there are at present 18 students
attending wood carving and engraving classes and that there
is at present a great demand for trained Instructors of
wood work and carving, as all the Instructors trained last
year have secured appointments and that there are still some
posts which are vacant for want of trained Instructors.

2. As the training given improves the drawing in schools by enabling drawing masters to realise that drawing should not be taught as an isolated subject limited to coping of patterns, but should be applied to indigenous Arts and Crafts and as the class in question is the only one of its kind where such a training is attended, both the Adviser and the Principal, Teachers' College, Saidapet, recommend the retention of the class and the establishment sanctioned therefor up to 31-3-1927.

3. I accordingly request that sanction be accorded to the continuance of the class and of the establishment sanctioned therefor up to the end of 31-3-1927.

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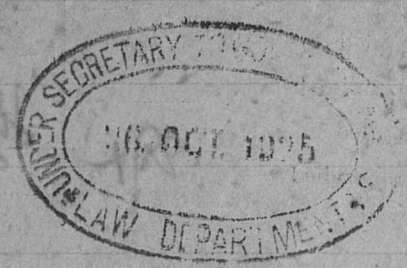
