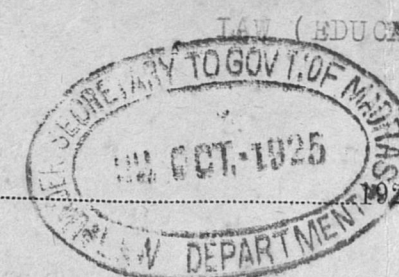

Sir,

In his letter, R.C.No.3456-D/22, dated the 2nd August 1923, submitting for the approval of Government the draft of the revised notification relating to the Government Technical Examinations, Mr. Littlehailes recommended the transfer of the subjects of the April Technical Examinations to the list of subjects for the November Examinations with a view chiefly to effecting a reduction in the expenditure under Superintendence, packing, postage &c., and this recommendation was approved by Government in their Order No.1769 Law (Education) dated the 20th December 1923. Examinations under the revised scheme, were accordingly held for the first time in 1924-25.

It has been represented to me by the Heads of schools of Commerce that the alteration in the dates of the examinations in the subjects included under "Commerce" has greatly affected the strength of their institutions and that unless a reversion to the old arrangement is made, there is likely to be a further decline in strength. The following statement showing the strength of the Government Institute of Commerce, Madras, at the end of the long and short terms during each of the three preceding years, illustrates the effect of the new arrangement on the strength of the institutions:-

Pupils for the Schools of Commerce are ordinarily drawn from the schools for general education and the school-year for these latter begins in June and ends in April. Pupils who complete their studies in schools for general education and who desire to proceed to Schools of Commerce are now obliged to wait till January following and this enforced break in the continuity of the school course takes away many an intending pupil from the Schools of Commerce. I have, therefore, the honour to recommend that the examinations in the subjects included under "Commerce" be moved from November to April. As regards the examinations in "Shorthand" and Typewriting" which are to be held twice a year, I propose that the second examination in these subjects be held in December instead of in November. This change is also suggested in the interests of Schools of Commerce. When examinations are held in November, the pupils have little to do in December and as a consequence the daily attendance is poor during that month.

2. I further recommend that the alterations in dates proposed herein may take effect from April 1926.

3. Since the holding of the examinations in all the "Commerce" subjects in April will increase the volume of work connected with the scrutiny of applications, the preparation

of nominal rolls, &c., I recommend that the latest date for the submission of applications for the April Examinations may be changed from the 28th February to the 31st January so as to allow adequate time to the office to do the work satisfactorily. The latest date for the submission of applications for the November and December examinations, except the examination in Minor Sanitary Engineering, may be changed from the 31st July to the 31st August, that for the examination in Minor Sanitary Engineering remaining as the 31st October as at present.

4. I enclose herewith a draft (in duplicate) of the modifications which will be necessary in the Notification relating to the Government Technical Examinations consequent on the changes proposed in the preceding paragraphs and request that Government will be pleased to accord their early approval to the modifications so as to enable me to publish the notice inviting applications for the examinations of April 1926 in December next.

(W) In the ^{not}modification, No.29, regarding Government Technical Examinations, published on pages 85-88 of Part I-B of the Port St. George Gazette, dated the 29th January 1924, as amended by Notification, No.91, published on page 189 of the Port St. George Gazette, dated the 5th May 1925, the following will be substituted for article 4:-

28.4.25 (Q) p.4 n f. a (W)
"The examinations shall be held at such centres as the Commissioner may, from time to time, select. The examinations in Shorthand and Typewriting will be held twice a year, once in April and again in December; those in the other subjects - included under the group headed "Commerce", will be held in April. The examinations in Animal Physiology (Higher Grade) and Hygiene (Higher Grade) and the examination in Minor Sanitary Engineering will be held in January and December, respectively; those in all the remaining subjects including the examinations in Animal Physiology (Lower Grade) and Hygiene (Lower Grade) will be held in November. The order of time and subjects in which the examinations will be held, will be published annually under the authority of the Commissioner in the Port St. George Gazette."

x p.6 n f. (W) For article 11 in the same notification, the following will be substituted:-

"Candidates must send in their applications for admission not later than 30th November for the January examinations, 31st January for the April examinations and 31st August for the November and December examinations, except the examination in Minor Sanitary Engineering for which the latest date will be 31st October. The applications must be on printed forms which may be obtained at the Office of the Commissioner and from all Tahsildars and Treasury Deputy Collectors.
