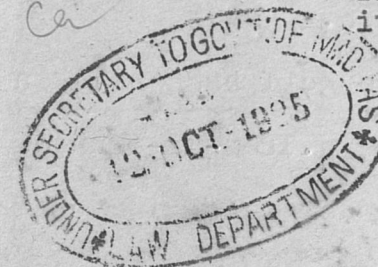

Sir,

I have the honour to state that in G.O. Mis.

83 Law (Education) dated 21-1-1925 Government sanctioned the payment to the Municipal Council, Salem of a subsidy of Rs.2784/- in 1924-25 towards the recurring and non-recurring charges of the Manual Training class in wood work attached to the School Department of the Municipal College Salem.

2. The Chairman, Municipal Council, Salem requests sanction for the continuance of the class during the current year and the payment of the necessary subsidy for its maintenance. From the statement showing the actual expenditure of the class during 1924-25 and the

amount required during 1925-26 (copy enclosed) it will be seen that out of the amounts of Rs.2785 and Rs.712 shown in G.O.Mis. 83 Law (Education) dated 21-1-1925 as the estimated non-recurring and recurring charges respectively of the class during 1924-25 a sum of Rs.608 only under the former and Rs.695 under the latter was spent in 1924-25.

It will thus be seen that the Council has still an unspent balance of subsidy amounting to Rs.1632-12-0 under non-recurring and Rs.12 approximately under recurring charges to its credit at the beginning of the current year.

3. The Principal reports that the whole of the balance under non-recurring will be spent during the current year - towards the purchase of tools, the construction of a store room and for enclosing the verandah of the shed so as to make it available for practical work. There will therefore be no balance left under this head.

4. As regards the recurring charges the Chairman requests that a subsidy equal to $\frac{3}{4}$ of the recurring charges of Rs.854 may be sanctioned to the Council as subsidy for the current year.

5. But according to the rules for the Grant-in-aid of vocational education the Council is eligible for only one half of the recurring charges, viz., Rs.427 during the second and subsequent years, the Council having received a subsidy equal to $\frac{3}{4}$ of the recurring charges in the year 1924-25 in which the class was started.

6. In view however of the fact that the Council has an unspent balance of Rs.12 to its credit as already stated the net amount payable as subsidy to it during the current year on account of the Manual Training class is Rs.415/- which is recommended for sanction, the expenditure being met from the provision of Rs.15,500 under grants-in-aid Educational - Voted - recurring, under 31 B(c) Education - Secondary, grants to local bodies for Secondary Education in the budget estimate for the current year.
