Sir,

I have the honour to invite a reference to rule 2(2) (page 36) of the Public Service Notification published in Part I of the Fort St. George Gazette dated 15th January 1924 wherein certain appointments have been excluded from the operation of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification and to state that there are also certain other posts, such as those mentioned below, in this department to which appointments are being made at present without taking into consideration whether the candidates possess the qualification prescribed in Article 1 of the Public Service Notification. I request therefore that these posts may be included under the list of

appointments excluded from the operation of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification. For these appointments, the chief requisites are technical qualifications and practical experience and not so much general educational qualifications, though in the case of the Supervisors and Mechanics and Weaving Superintendents a working knowledge of English will be insisted on and, where practicable, those possessing the minimum general educational qualifications prescribed in Article 1 of the notification will be given preference.

(1) Supervisors The pay of this class of officer is Rs. 100.-5.-175 E grade and Rs. 180.-10.-250 F grade. J. T. Institute, Bombay. To Asst. Secretary

For qualification for admission to (i) the Engineer class and (ii) for the Probationary Subordinate class, attention is solicited to page 26 and 27 of the Engineering College Calendar. Candidates for admission into the Engineer class must have passed the Intermediate examination of the Madras University with group I as the optimal branch or an examination accepted by the D.P.C. as equivalent. Thereafter. For the Probationary subordinate class, candidates must be either holders of completed Secondary School Leaving Certificates considered by the Principal of the College as satisfactory or must have passed the Matriculation examination or an examination accepted by Gvt. as equivalent. Thereafter.

In regard to the Victoria Jubilee Technical Institute, the candidates for admission to the Mechanical, Electrical and Chemical departments were originally required to have ^{completed} passed the first year's course in an University. Candidates for admission to all sections in the Institute should pass the Entrance Examination of the Institute. Preference is given to candidates who have passed the first year's Course in a College affiliated to a recognised University. The standard of examination is more or less the matriculation or the School Final examination. Candidates for Madras Gvt. Scholarships should in any case be holders of Secondary School Leaving Certificates and generally those who have got high marks are selected. From the above it will be seen that men who have passed out of the Victoria Jubilee Technical Institute will be men with the minimum general educational qualification prescribed in Article 1 of the Public Service Notification. It was in these circumstances suggested that there was no need to exempt the posts of Supervisors and the Training Superintendents from this Article.

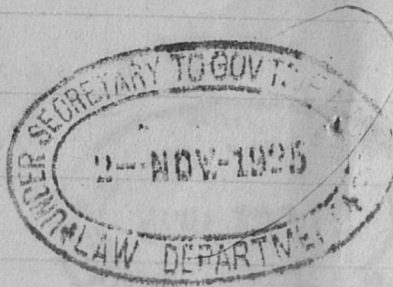
