Sir.

In submitting herewith a copy of letter C.No. 413 G1/25, dated 3rd October 1925 from Mr.S.A. Steele, District Educational Officer, Salem requesting that under the circumstances explained therein, his action in having accepted a small Silver trowel valued at Rs 3½ from the Manager, Aided Elementary School, Tharamangalam may be approved and that he may be allowed to retain the trowel, I have the honour to recommend that under the revised rule 4 of the Government Servants Conduct Rules Government may be pleased to approve of Mr. Steele's action and to allow him to retain the trowel. In this connection I have the honour to report that I also had to accept a similar trowel at Erode in July last on the

occasion of the laying of the foundation stone of the Mahajana Sabha High School. Considering the insignificant value of the trowel, I did not think it worth while troubling about ^{but} having considered the point in connection with Mr. Steele's application it is clear that I ought to have addressed Government. I therefore do so now and request that sanction may be accorded on behalf both of Mr. Steele and of myself.

Copy of letter C.No. 413 Gl/25, dated 3rd October 1925 of ~~the~~ Mr. S.A. Steele, District Educational Officer, Salem to the Director of Public Instruction, Madras.

I have the honour to state that at the request of the manager of the aided elementary school, Tharamangalam, I presided over the annual prize distribution function and also laid the foundation stone of the proposed building for the school on 2nd October 1925.

2. The manager handed me at the latter function a small silver trowel valued at Rs 3½. I told him that I am forbidden to accept any such presentation at ceremonial functions in my capacity as a Government servant but the manager insisted upon my receiving it and made me understand that my refusal to receive the same would be dishonouring the manager and the institution.

3. At the outset I did not anticipate that I would be presented with such a thing, otherwise I would have either declined to be present for the occasion or obtained the previous sanction of the Local Government as required in Rule 4 of the Government -- Servants' Conduct Rules.

4. I went to Tharamangalam, a distance of 17 miles from Salem and returned after 3 hours stay there and I do not claim any travelling allowance for my journeys to and fro.

5. Under these circumstances, I request you will be so good as to approve of my action and kindly allow me to retain the trowel as its value is very small.
