Mr. C.T. Mullings, the present Chief Engineer for Irrigation, states that he has no suggestions to make in the way of altering or supplementing the information given in the original edition of the Manual. The copy forwarded with the U.O. note will be retained so that as many corrections as possible may be carried out in the Manual which is reported by the Superintendent of the Government Press to be ready for the striking off of final copies. It is requested that sanction may be accorded to the printing of 1500 copies. This is the number suggested by the Principal of the College of Engineering. If this higher number is approved it will save trouble and probably expense in the end as those not required for immediate use this year can be stocked and issued to students in future years.

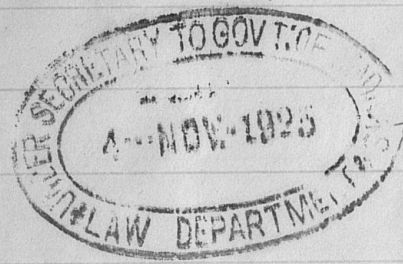

 the book was ordered to be reprinted
 there were no directions for the
 supply of copies to Govt. officers or
 institutions. Apparently at the instance
 of the D.P.D.; the Press has supplied
 copies to Govt. officers. The S. G. P. has
 been requested w/o to say how many
 copies were distributed & to whom.
