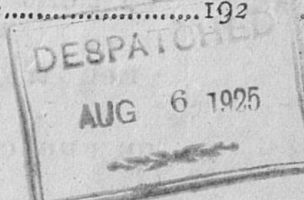

In enclosing a copy of the Audit objection for the expenditure on the purchase of harmoniums, I have the honour to state that the harmoniums were purchased for the Girls schools as the female teachers employed in schools know a little to teach the girls of their respective schools. The employment of a separate ~~teacher~~ music teacher has improved the schools and the instruction given in the music is more attractive and useful than the instruction given by the teachers in girls schools. I request that the Government may be pleased to approve of the expenditure met from provincial Funds.

In view of the fact that Government have not sanctioned the payment of the salary of the music teacher from the Elementary Education Fund, it is doubtful whether charges on musical instruments are intended to be a charge on the Fund. The approval of the Government may be obtained.

2. The Auditor's objection relates to the expenditure being incurred out of the Elementary Education Fund. I submit that with regard to note (3) to clause (b) of the rules framed under section 3(v) of the Madras Elementary Education Act of 1920 the expenditure on account of the imparting of instruction in music is a legitimate charge on Elementary Education fund. But as regards the use of harmoniums instead of Vina or Violin, reference is invited to para.2 of G.O. No.659 M.Ms. dated 14-5-1920.

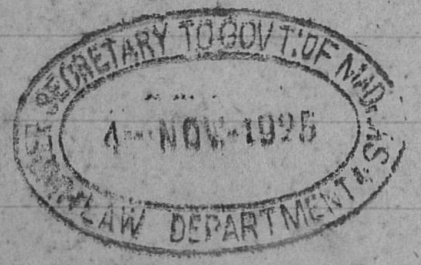
