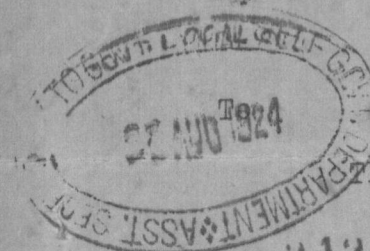

The Walluvanad Taluk Board has resolved to give Adi-Dravida children attending board schools umbrellas made of palmyrah leaves with a view to encourage their attendance at schools. 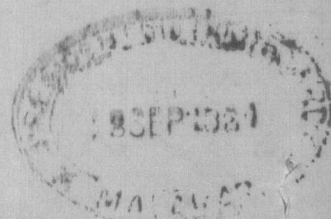

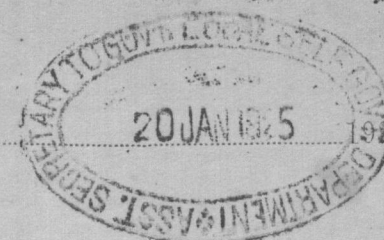

the necessity for the supply is admitted the debiting

of expenditure on this account, to the Elementary

Education fund would be inadmissible, as it is not

educational expenditure. The District Educational

In G.O.No.1890 Law(Education) dated 3-12-24, ~~the~~ expenditure from the Elementary Education fund on account of feeding Adi Dravida children has already been prohibited. Feeding and clothing are alike, and the expenditure incurred on supplying clothes cannot be treated as educational expenditure. [Attention is also invited to para 2 of my letter R.C.No.2282 B/24 dated 20-12-1924 addressed to Government in the Law (Education) Department.]
