Whereas Satayanarain son of Gurna Aiyar, resident of village _____ parganna _____ district Madras, has on the 19th day of June 1925, been convicted by Rai M. Nahar Bahadur _____ at Juvenile Court of the offence of Theft as a servant section 381 I.P.C. and has been sentenced to ~~be~~ rigorous imprisonment for three (3) months which sentence he is now undergoing in the House of Detention.

And whereas the said Satya Narain is under the age of fifteen years and is a proper person to be an inmate of a Reformatory school.

It is therefore ordered that, instead of undergoing his sentence, he be detained for a period of six (6) years in the Reformatory School at Hazaribagh.
