Subject: -- Women's Christian College, Madras.

The Women's Christian College, Madras, was started in the year 1915 as a first grade college. The college is residential and provides accommodation for 10 professors and about 120 students. Special provision is made for games and physical exercise. All Indian students, except those whose parents reside in Madras, are expected to join the college as residential students.

2. The College is affiliated to the University in Group (iii) (Natural Science, Botany with Zoology Subsidiary), Group (iv) (Logic, Psychology and Ethics) and Group (v) (History and Economics) of the B.A. Pass Course; and Group (i) (Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry), Group (ii) (Natural Science, Physics and Chemistry) and Group (iii) of the Intermediate Course (Ancient History, Modern History, Logic, and Languages).

3. The strength of the college classes during the year 1924 was 137, distributed as shown below:--

In September 1922 the D.P.I. submitted plans and estimates ^(amounting to Rs. 50 lakhs) for the construction of a science block and a college hall for this college, and requested that the scheme ^{might} be included in the list of approved works maintained for the purpose. The proposal was accepted by the Government in G.O. 1200 dd. 9-10-22, and the scheme was declared eligible for a grant of $\frac{2}{3}$ of the cost in the case of the science block and of one-half of the cost in the case of the college hall.

The Government have also sanctioned a grant of Rs. 96,000 for the equipment of the science block and the college hall. It has been ascertained from the Director's office that a sum of Rs. 2,14,883 out of the grant sanctioned for the building and Rs. 53,315 out of the grant for equipment have actually been disbursed till now. The file may be circulated to H. E. the Governor through M2.
