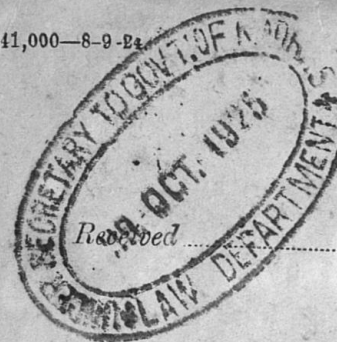

Sir.

K. Ratnam was appointed on 17th February 1923 as acting Physical Training Instructor, Government Training School, Nellore on Rs 30 plus 10 in the old scale before the issue of G.O. No. 1063, Law (Education) dated 2nd August 1923 but was ousted from service on 2nd May 1923. The revised scale sanctioned for the post in the above G.O. is Rs 25-1-50, Hence he has to refund a sum of Rs 36-14-0 overdrawn during the period from 17th February 1923 to 1st May 1923. But the District Educational Officer, Nellore has reported that there is no hope of recovering the excess as the person concerned is still unemployed.

2. R. Srinivasa Raghavachariya was similarly entertained on Rs 30/- as acting Drawing master, Government Training School, Tiruvalur (now at Tanjore) from 4th July 1923 i.e. before the issue of G.O.No. 1063 Law (Education) dated 2nd August 1923. As the revised scale sanctioned for this post also is Rs 25-50, he has to refund a sum of Rs 4-8-3 overdrawn during the period from 4th July 1923 to 31st July 1923. As the overpayments referred to ~~to~~ above were made to the subordinates concerned on account of the delay in the issue of the orders contained in G.O.No. 1063, Law (Education) dated 2nd August 1923 revising the pay of the posts they held, I have the honour to recommend that the excess drawn by these two subordinates may be waived under para 2(1) of G.O.No. 647, Finance, dated 6th September 1924. Government were pleased to sanction the waiver in a similar case in G.O.No. 1391, Law (Education) dated 13th August 1925.
