Sir,

I have the honour to state that in G.Os.Nos. 34 Law(Education) dated 9- 1- 24 and Misc. 312 Law (Education) dated 4- 3- 25 Government sanctioned a subsidy of Rs.1676 towards the recurring and non-recurring charges of the Manual Training Class in Weaving in the Board boys Elementary School, Thathayangarpettai under the Musiri Taluk Board.

2. The President, Taluk Board, Musiri now requests that a net amount of subsidy of Rs.277 be Rs.450-Rs.173=-Rs.277 sanctioned to the Taluk Board towards the maintenance of the class during the current year. (1925-26.)

3. From the statement showing the details of expenditure

expenditure of the weaving class during 1924- 25 furnished by him it is observed that a sum of Rs.980/- has approximately been spent under non-recurring charges and of Rs.522 under recurring charges, thus leaving an unspent balance of Rs.93 under the former, and of Rs.81 under the latter.

4. According to the estimate of recurring charges of the class for the current year furnished by him, the total cost of running the class during 1925- 26 comes to Rs.888 as per details noted in the margin.

5. The Adviser to Government on Manual and Vocational

Training who inspected the class on 7- 9- 25 reports that there are in all 45 pupils belonging to classes IV and V who receive 1½ hours of instruction per day and that the work of the class was satisfactory.

6. He recommends a sum of Rs.30 under initial expenditure for the purchase of wire healds for want of which a loom is reported to be lying idle, and a sum of Rs.720 for the recurring charges of the class during the current year as per details given in the margin.

7. I recommend that the class be continued

during the year and that the entire non-recurring cost of Rs.30 and ½ the recurring cost of Rs.360 be sanctioned to it for its maintenance during the current year.

As however the Board has an unspent balance of Rs.174 to its credit as already stated above, the net amount of subsidy payable to it will be Rs.216 which may be sanctioned, the expenditure being Rs.390-174 or Rs.216 met from the provision of Rs.6300 under grants-in-aid Educational- voted- recurring- manual training under 31 C(c) i Education- Primary- Grants to Local bodies for Primary Education in the current years budget.

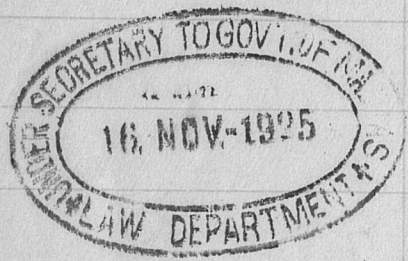

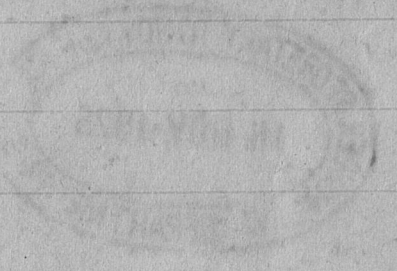
