Sir,

With reference to paragraph 3 of my letter R.O.C. No. 612-E/25, dated the 27th May 1925 and paragraph 2 of G.O. No. 1033, Law (Education), dated the 19th June 1925, I have the honour to state that the Superintendent, Lovedale Training School reports that he has received 11 applications for admission into the school in January 1926, - 2 from candidates who have passed the European High School examination, 6 from those who are appearing for that examination this year, 2 from those appearing for the Intermediate examination and from one who is appearing for the Senior Cambridge examination and that he expects further applications. In G.O. No. 8, Law (Education), dated the 3rd January 1925, Government --

Government while sanctioning the continuance of this school for a further period of two years from January 1925, have approved the proposal that admissions to the school should be made every year and that they should be restricted to -- middle grade candidates. As there is a fair number of -- applicants for middle grade training for fresh admissions in January 1926, I beg to recommend the continuance of the school for a further period of two years from January 1927 on the same financial arrangements as at present. The -- necessary provision for the purpose has been made in Part I budget for 1926-27.

2. The Superintendent requests permission for the admission of two candidates for ~~higher~~ grade training. He has not -- stated whether in the event of this being permitted, the present staff could manage the work or whether any additional staff will be required and in the latter case how he would propose to meet the extra charge. I am asking him for information on these points, and shall address Government on receipt of his reply. It may be mentioned that the Imperial grant - referred to in paragraph 7 of G.O. No. 167 Law (Education), dated the 29th January 1923 fetches an interest of about - Rs. 9,400 a year which is just about the amount required for meeting the expenditure of the school at the scale fixed in paragraph 4 of that G.O., and which will not suffice to meet the extra cost in the event of additional staff being required for the training of high grade candidates.

3. The Superintendent states that the accommodation in the present rented building is quite inadequate for a second - batch of students, and requests early orders regarding the further continuance of the school so that he may make ---- arrangements for buying and building a separate house before February 1926. It seems advisable to ~~avoid~~ ^{avoid}, if possible, either buying or building a separate house until the school is permanently established. It will be observed that the scale of rent sanctioned for the school in paragraph 4 of G.O. No. 167 Law (Education), dated the 29th January 1923 is Rs. 3,000/- per annum or Rs. 250 per mensem, while the

the rent paid for the present building is only Rs. 120 per mensem. Endeavours should be made to secure a larger building for rent up to Rs. 250 per mensem, and I am informing the -- Superintendent accordingly. The question of building need only be considered at present if suitable accommodation for rent cannot be secured.

4. The favour of very early orders is requested on this letter.
