Law (Education) Department

Orders regarding the constitution of District Secondary Education Boards were issued in January 1923. It was expected that election of members to the Boards would take place in May 1923. The elections in a few districts were held in that month; in other districts much later. Reports of the elections held in all the districts were received in August 1923. The question of filling seats reserved for nomination was taken up there-after. The lists of elected and nominated members were notified in the Fort St. George Gazette in October 1923. It is not known when exactly each Board held its first meeting. The following answer is for approval.

"The Boards were constituted about the end of 1923"

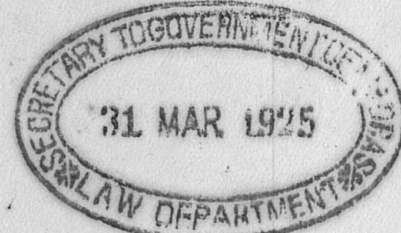

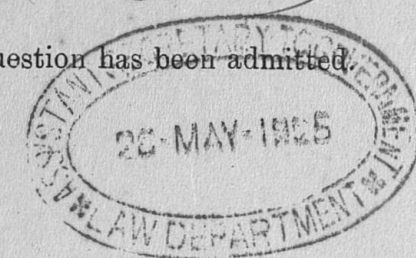
