C. No. 2504 B - From the Director of Public Instruction, No. R.O.C. 1388 C/25, dated 14-9-25.

Subject.- Payment of an honorarium to Mr. C.R. Porrett for the compilation of certain bulletins on Manual Training.

The Director of Public Instruction proposes to pay an honorarium of Rs 200 to Mr. Porrett, the Adviser to Government on Manual Training, for writing two bulletins on subjects relating to manual training and requests sanction to meet the charge from the savings in the current year's budget provision.

The necessity for the grant of the honorarium has not been fully explained. Mr. Porrett has published several bulletins ~~on~~ manual training in previous years and no special remuneration was given for the work. The Teachers' College, Saidapet, issues bulletins on various subjects from time to time and no honorarium is paid for the production of such bulletins. Under Fundamental rule 46 a Government servant may be granted an honorarium from general revenues in return for work which is of such exceptional merit or of such an arduous or peculiar nature as to justify a special reward. The D.P.I. may be requested U.O. to ~~the~~ explain the necessity for the grant of honorarium more fully in the present case.

Attention is invited to G.O. No. 1244 L.E., dated 7th September 1921 wherein Government stated that an honorarium of Rs. 200 was sufficient for the production by Mr. Porrett of certain pamphlets and drawing charts. This amount was accordingly sanctioned by the D.P.I. and in the present case I consider that the work done was of sufficient merit and involved such additional and arduous work as to justify the grant of an honorarium. Government will, I believe, be convinced of this while looking into the two bulletins, copies of which are attached to this U.O. reply. It is quite true that the Teachers' College, Saidapet, issues on various subjects from time to time and that an honorarium has not been paid in every case for the production of such bulletins. It may further be mentioned that Miss Gordon, Kindergarten Lecturer of the College, was paid an honorarium of Rs. 100 as the author of a bulletin entitled "Mental Intelligence Tests". If the authors of other bulletins had applied for the grant of an honorarium I might have held myself justified in some cases at least in recommending one just as I do feel justified in this particular case.

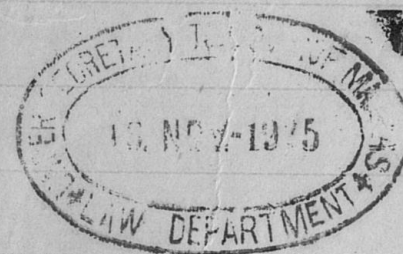

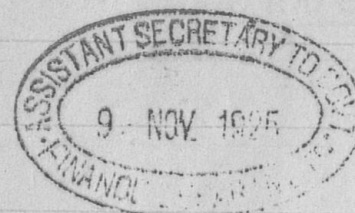
