Service Notification - M. Narayana Nambiyar, Sub-Inspector,
Southern Division.

Sir,

I have the honour to request that Government
will be pleased to accord sanction for the permanent --
exemption of M. Narayana Nambiyar, S.P.T. Sub Inspector
of Salt, IV grade from the provisions of Article 1 of the
Public Service Notification for employment as a perma-
nent Sub Inspector in the Salt Department. In consideration
of his war services, this Sub Inspector was temporarily
exempted from the Examination rules for a period of one
year in 1922 for employment as Sub Inspector in acting,
temporary and S.P.T. vacancies. The local officers
reported that the Sub Inspector had worked quite satis-
factorily and the period of exemption was extended by
another year in B.P.No.1728, Salt, dated 12th November
1923. The question of exempting the Sub Inspector
permanently was deferred till the separate ^{com} of the Salt
and Excise Departments. The Assistant Commissioner,
Southern Division, now requests that the Sub Inspector
may be permanently exempted as his work continues to be
satisfactory and I support the request.

Application for exemption from the Examination Rules of an unpassed candidate
for employment in the office of as Sub-Inspector in the Madras
Salt Department.

1. Name, age and educational qualifications of the unpassed candidate, for whose exemption sanction is sought. **M. Narayana Nambiyar,**
Age on 30-10-25 - 32 years 7 months and 20 days. Has completed the S.S.L.C. Course, but did not appear for the examination.
2. The post in which it is proposed to employ him and nature of the appointment, i.e., whether acting or sub. *pro tem.* or temporary. **Sub Inspector of Salt Dept. Permanent.**
3. The sanctioned pay of the post and the pay proposed to be given to the unpassed candidate. **Rs.60/- to Rs.90/-.**
