Sir.

In G.O.No.962 Law (Education) dated 8-6-25 Government while approving the scheme for the opening of Manual Training classes in wood work and mechanical drawing, clay-modelling, basket-making, card-board modelling and gardening in the American Mission High & Training Schools, Pasumalai, stated that the estimate of Rs.27,000 for the construction of a building for the manual training classes was exceedingly high and that plans and estimates for a permanent building at a cheaper cost may be prepared.

2. The Correspondent of the school who was accordingly asked to submit revised plans and estimates for a building at a cheaper cost has now resubmitted the same plans

stating

(P.T.O)

stating that the management have gone most carefully into the matter in all its details and are convinced that it would be a mistake and false economy to erect a cheaper building, and that the plans as originally designed provide for the minimum requirements viz., a central building fitted up for the special purpose which will accommodate the several manual training classes with a total strength of over 800 students. The Adviser to Government supports the correspondent's proposal to construct the building as originally designed.

3. The management are now prepared to accept even a half grant on the original estimate instead of a 2/3rds grant which they first asked for. If, however, Government are not willing to consider favourably the Correspondent's request for a $\frac{1}{2}$ grant on the original estimate of Rs.27,000 he suggests that an alternative plan will be to postpone for the present the building of the two wings and to erect only the main building using the two lower rooms temporarily for the wood work classes. This, however, he does not consider to be a satisfactory arrangement.

4. The cost of constructing the main building alone as per estimate furnished by him comes to Rs.17,760.

5. The Deputy ^{Special} Consulting Architect, to whom the plans and the revised estimates of the Correspondent were forwarded for professional advice, is of opinion that Rs.16,500 is the utmost that can be allowed for the main portion of the building.

6. Though the management are willing to accept the revised estimate as modified by the Deputy ^{Special} Consulting Architect owing to the pressing need for building, they still feel that it would be in every way best to complete the building as originally planned.

7. I cannot recommend a grant on more than what the Consulting Architect considers reasonable. The management can however adopt their original design if they like, but must pay the difference themselves.

8. The plans and the revised estimate received from the Correspondent are also submitted herewith for reference and return when done with.

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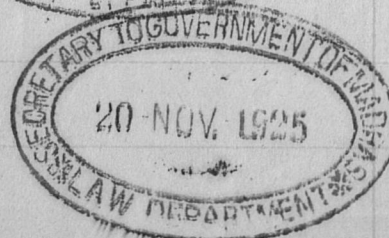
