Sir.

I have the honour to bring to the notice of Government that out of 52 scholarships tenable in the IVth year University class (48 sanctionable under the General scholarship notification published on page 307 of Part I-B of the Fort St. George Gazette dated 28th July 1925 and 4 special collegiate scholarships for Muhammadans awarded under the scholarship notification published on pages 298 and 299 of Part I-B of the Fort St. George - Gazette dated 21st July 1925) 51 were renewed in Director's Proceedings R.C.No.665-E/25 dated 3-9-1925. One scholarship held in 1924-25 by D.Kodan, IVth Class of the Christian College, Madras, was not renewed, owing

to the fact that, in the application for renewal of the student's scholarship during the current year, the number and date of Director's Proceedings sanctioning the scholarship in 1924-25 were incorrectly quoted by the correspondent of the college. The student's name did not occur in the consolidated list of last year's awards, as the award of the scholarship last year was sanctioned in a separate Proceedings. D. Kodan is the Toda student who was drawing the special scholarships sanctioned in G.Os.No.1748 Law (Education) dated 6-12-'21, and No.1010 Law (Education) dated 31-8-1922 in the Junior and Senior Intermediate classes respectively. He was awarded an ordinary collegiate scholarship in the IIIrd-year class in 1924-25. Owing to the absence of his name from the consolidated list and the inability to trace the order sanctioning the scholarship last year, it was inadvertently assumed that D. Kodan's scholarship had lapsed. It may be mentioned here that the clerk who has been dealing with scholarships for the last two years is no longer in the office and that the Acting Director and the Acting Deputy Director were not cognizant of the award of a scholarship last year to D.Kodan, as the scholarship was awarded before they joined the office.

The scholarship thus wrongly assumed to have lapsed was awarded to one P.Seetharamayya. The attention of the Government is in this connection invited to Law (Education) Memorandum No.960-C/25-1 dated the 26th March 1925, which refers to this student.

The Director's orders sanctioning the award of a scholarship to D.Kodan in 1924-25 have since been traced and it therefore becomes necessary to renew his scholarship for the current year. This cannot be done unless the scholarship awarded to P.Seetharamayya is cancelled or unless an additional scholarship is sanctioned. ~~Unless one or the other course were adopted the total number of scholarships awarded will be 53, one in excess of the number sanctioned.~~

I therefore request you to be good enough to sanction for the current year only, the award of an additional scholarship tenable in the 4th year University class. The amount required, Rs.168(Rs.14 x 12 months - July 1925 to June 1926) may be met from savings under the current year's budget provision of Rs.47,000 for "Scholarships in Arts Colleges".

The error pointed out above is deeply regretted and steps are being taken to see that such errors will not occur again in future.
