Sir,

I have the honour to request that Government will be pleased to accord sanction for the permanent exemption of T. Veeraswami Nayudu, acting Sub Inspector of Salt, 4th Grade, from the provisions of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification for employment as a permanent Sub Inspector in the Salt Department. This Sub Inspector belongs to a respectable military family and he was temporarily exempted from the examination rules in 1912 for employment as Sub Inspector in acting, temporary and sub-pro-tem vacancies. He was first tried as an acting Sub Inspector in April 1913 for a month and again in 1916. From 15-2-1920 he has been working continuously as an acting or sub-pro-tem Sub Inspector. The local officers report

that

that the work of the Sub Inspector has been entirely satisfactory and that he possesses the knowledge of an average School Final candidate. In these circumstances I request that the Sub Inspector may be permanently exempted from the provisions of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification.
