Sir,

I have the honour to bring to your kind notice that the present financial position of this Taluk Board so far relating to the Elementary Education Fund, is in a very precarious condition, and funds required for expenditure on account of Elementary Education could not be easily transferred from the General Account without fear of reducing the financial stability of the latter very often. The result of this, is that the school-masters suffer on account of the delay in the disbursement

ment

disbursement of salary etc., which has to be done only after having the necessary amount got adjusted from General Funds to Elementary Education Accounts. Owing to heavy expenditure in the Engineering works and other important branches, the balance of the Taluk Board under the General Funds for the past four months has become very much reduced as per figures furnished in the ** margin as a result of which, funds required for expenditure under Elementary Education excluding the Government grant have to be transferred to the Elementary Education Funds only after the monthly adjustment of the Land Cess which is adjusted after the 15th of every month. The Education grant also, payable by Government -- though vouchers are produced before the 10th of every month is adjusted only after the 20th or so, with the result that for the payment of school-masters' salaries etc., which come to Rs.2700/- and odd per mensem, these two items of grant -- have to be depended upon, and consequently there is delay in the payment of the salaries of school-masters every month. The figures of closing balance furnished above, would show that no amounts could be transferred from the General Funds to the -- Elementary Education Funds until the adjustment of the Land Cess. The Taluk Board cannot also at the same time postpone the execution of road and other works and avoid lump sum expenditure on account of payments of medical bills.

2. The total amount of Government grant due to this Board on account of Elementary Education is Rs.12552/- for a year, and it is being adjusted on a monthly rate of Rs.1046/-. Vide G.O. Nos. 545 and 546 L.E dated 17--4--25. According to the above Government Orders the grant is to be adjusted on the 15th of every month, and not before.

In the circumstances, I request that you will be good enough to take into consideration the poor finances of

this Board and to order as a special case the adjustment of the total amount of the Education grant due for the current year from 1--10--25 onwards in a lump sum in view of the peculiar circumstances explained supra so that the poor school-masters may be paid their salaries in time. No doubt under the -- existing rules, the Taluk Board cannot divert any portion of the funds constituted under Elementary Education Account for any other purpose.

The favour of an early reply is requested.
