P. Venkatarangam Nayudu, an unpassed temporary clerk who has put in long and satisfactory service in the Department, was recently appointed by the Superintending Engineer, Coimbatore Circle, as a provisionally permanent clerk on Rs. 35-60. He was first recruited for clerical work on 19-5-18 and it is stated that previous to that date he was working for a long time as a Maistry. He has earned very good reports from the several officers under whom he served and his work is reported to have been uniformly satisfactory. In consideration of this and of the principles regarding communal representation in the public services, I approve of the Superintending Engineer's action in having appointed this unpassed candidate.

He has to be exempted from article 1 of the Public Service Notification. He was last granted temporary exemption in G.O. No. 149 Law (Education), dated 17-3-22. Having regard to the provisions of para. 2(v) of G.O. No. 722-Law (Education), dated 13-6-1922, sanction of Government would appear necessary for the permanent exemption of this clerk. I request that sanction may be obtained with retrospective effect from the date of the clerk's appointment. (ie, 1.5.25 - vide ca. 6 on p3 infra)

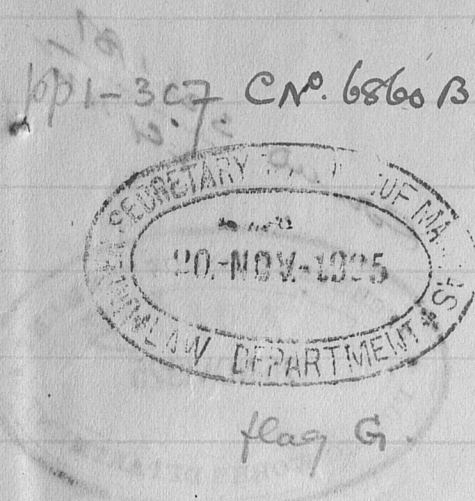

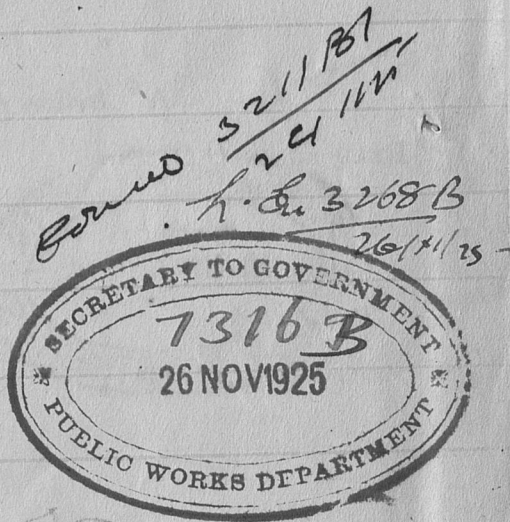
