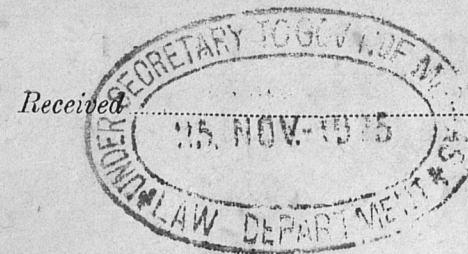

Endorsement on letter R.C.No.82/23 dated 18-9-1925 from the President, Taluk Board, Udayapalayam.

Submitted to Government.

2. The Taluk Board proposes to utilise a sum of Rs.5800 on repairs etc out of the accumulated balance - available in the Elementary Education Fund under its control and this amount is over and above the provision of Rs.5000 made in the budget estimate for 1925-26 and approved in G.O. No.1117 Mis. Law (Education) dated 29-6-1925. In view of the fact that there is a very large closing balance in the Elementary Education Fund and as almost all the school-less centres with a population 500 and above, have been provided with schools, I recommend

that the President's request to utilise the sum of Rs.5800 from the Elementary Education fund in addition to the sum of Rs.5000 provided in the Board's budget, may be sanctioned.

I have the honour to state that there are many school buildings owned by the Board. Some of them as per enclosed statement require urgent repairs while in some others the accommodation is too inadequate to hold all the pupils. I often hear that admission of new pupils are refused for want of accommodation. The General fund of this Board is very limited and it cannot offered to maintain those buildings in good condition to make any improvements to them. The Board cannot allow its school buildings to go into ruins on any account. The extension of the buildings whenever required is also a necessity which cannot be postponed. There is no balance at all in the General account of the Board but the balance under the Educational account will allow such works to be done from that resource. The interest of the proper upkeep of these buildings and of expanding Elementary education by giving proper facilities for accommodation I have the honour to request that the Government may be pleased to accord sanction as a special case for the utilization of Educational Cess for the works given in the educational statement.
