In their order read above, Government have
refused to exempt Mr. V. Narasimha Ayya from the examination
rules for employment as Upper Division clerk on Rs.65-4-125
They have at the same time directed that the application may
be renewed after the clerk has reached the maximum scale of
pay.

2. The grade in which the clerk is at present
employed is in the scale of Rs.40, 40-2½-65- 3 - 80. His
present pay is Rs.65/ It will take 10 years more for him
to reach the maximum of Rs.80/- It was already pointed out

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out to Government in Commissioner's reference dated 10-9-25 that the clerk has already put in 17 years' service. When he reaches the maximum he would have put in 27 years' service. He would therefore be at the fag end of his service and about to retire. The clerk will practically derive no benefit by ~~raising~~ raising the question of exemption after he reaches the -- maximum in the present scale of pay.

3. The Commissioner in this connection desires to point out to Government that such exemptions of unpassed clerks for promotion to higher grades are very rarely recommended. Such recommendations are made only when the candidates are in his opinion fit to be promoted to that grade. Mr. V. Narasimha Ayya has put in 17 years' service and has gained much experience. He is at present doing the work, which is ordinarily done by an Upper Division clerk, to the entire satisfaction of the Commissioner. He richly deserves an Upper Division clerk's post for which he is well fitted.

4. The Commissioner therefore requests that Government may be pleased to recognise the clerk's good work and reconsider their orders and exempt Mr. V. Narasimha Ayya from the examination rules for promotion to the grade of Rs.65-4-125/-
