I have the honour to submit herewith a copy of letter dated 12-10-1925 from A. Aeron together with the endorsement dated 12-10-1925 of the Chairman, Municipal Council, Ootacamund, and to state that A. Aeron received Rs.145-3-0 as stipends and travelling allowance while he was under taining in the Teachers' College, Saidapet, during 1923-24. Reckoning the 16 months of approved service already put in by the applicant as a teacher, the proportionate amount that will have to be refunded by him comes to about Rs.81. The Chairman, Municipal Council, requests that the applicant may be released from the complete fulfilment of the terms of the bond. But under Rule 125(ii) of the Madras Educational Rules

VI edition, the Director is not empowered to grant exemption from the fulfilment of the terms of the bond in the circumstances stated by the applicant. In view of the special circumstances of the case and taking also into consideration the various educational activities of Mr. Aeron, I would recommend that the completion of fulfilment of the terms of the bond may be deferred for a year for the present with effect from 1st August 1925.

Copy of letter dated 12th October 1925 from A. Aeron, Y.M.C.A. Ootacamund, to the Director of Public Instruction, Madras.

I took my L.T. course in the Saidapet Teachers' College during the year 1923-24 and took my degree in August 1924. From April 1924 for 16 months I have been Headmaster of the C.E.Z.M. Girls' High school, Dunmere Fern Hill. As the High school department of this school is to be closed down I have left the school and have taken up the paid general Secretaryship of the Ootacamund Young Men's Christian Association. As the Secretary of the Y.M.C.A., I am still doing educational work by trying to promote adult education through lantern lectures and night schools. I am also an Honorary teacher in the Narayana Gurukula, Fern Hill. As a Municipal Councillor I am taking interest in Elementary Education and I have been representing the Ooty Municipality on the District Educational Council. As the District Secretary of the Nilgiri District Scout Council I have been promoting the Scout Movement on the hills and I am Scout Master of the Municipal High school and the Y.M.C.A. troops.

• Taking these into consideration I hope you will kindly exempt me from my obligation to serve in a -- recognised school for another 20 months according to the bond I have executed while I took up my L.T. Course.

Copy of endorsement dated 12th October 1925 of the Chairman, Municipal Council, Ootacamund.

With reference to the enclosed and Mr. Aaron's bond, I have to point out that I discussed the matter with the Hon'ble the Minister for Education when I was in Madras on the 7th instant. The Minister kindly - permitted me to represent the matter to you in the first instance and said he would do what was necessary on your recommendations. I have already seen you with regard to the closing of Miss Ling's High school and it
