Sir,
I have the honour to state that the Non-Gazetted Educational Officers' Association suggested to me that the Linguistic Portion of the Deputy Inspector's test might be abolished. I invited the views of the District Educational Officers on the proposal. While a few of them recommended the abolition of the test, the majority including the most experienced District Educational Officers were for its retention. As there are many districts which are bilingual and as there is not a sufficient number of men in the Deputy Inspector's cadre both able and willing to serve in ranges which are not unilingual, I support the latter view viz that the test cannot be abolished at present.

3. As the next examination is to be held in April next, I propose to give effect to the change from 1926.
