In the circumstances stated, Miss E.A. Fuller, appointed to the temporary post of Sub-Assistant Inspectress of Girls' Schools, Madras Girls' Range, sanctioned in G.O.No. 1894 Law (Education) dated 4-12-1924 is exempted from the liability to maintain a conveyance of her own. She is permitted to draw the conveyance allowance of Rs. 50 a month — ~~long as she holds the temporary post and~~ to make such arrangements for her conveyance as she finds ^{may} ~~it~~ convenient.

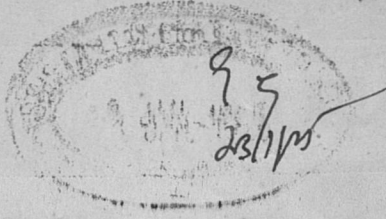

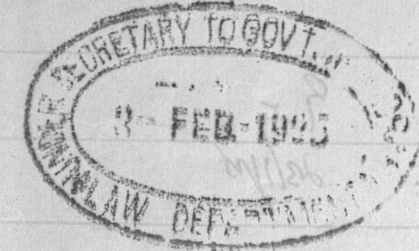
to waive this condition is opposed to the decision of the Cabinet that conveyance allowance should be restricted to allowances for maintenance of particular conveyances.

The D.P.I. has fully explained the necessity for exempting this officer from the liability to maintain a conveyance of her own. She is posted to the appointment only temporarily and it will be hard upon her to make her invest money in a conveyance which may not be useful to her if she is transferred to another charge. It is also stated that the house in which she lives at present has no accommodation for keeping a conveyance and she will have to shift from the house for such a small period if the condition Again the concession asked for is only personal as to conveyance is insisted on. Even though she may not be maintaining a conveyance ^{she} will have to hire one to visit the schools in distant parts of the city for which she will not be eligible for any allowance if she is brought under the ordinary travelling allowance rules.

In these circumstances it is for orders whether the exemption asked may not be granted as a special case.
