Attention is solicited to G.O. No. 164 Law (Edn.), ~~dated~~ 4th February 1925, in which the Government laid down that such of the "unpassed clerks" as have not been specifically exempted from the examination rules should not be granted increments in the time scales of pay. ~~It has recently been decided that~~

These orders apply to persons holding officiating or temporary appointments. ^{In cases where} ~~where~~ clerks who have not been exempted have ^{already} drawn increments, the Government has stated that they will consider applications for waiver of recovery of the increments paid to them. The resolution M.L.Cs. who have given notice of the resolution on page 2 ante apparently desire that the orders in G.O. 164, ~~dated~~ 4-2-25, should be cancelled. This, it is submitted, cannot be agreed to.
