correction may be made now.

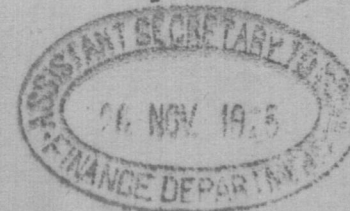
With reference to the notes in memo. No. 3300C-1,
