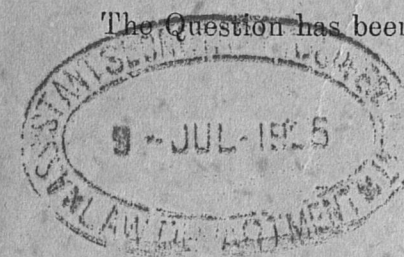

Clause (a) and (b) of the question

The Municipal Council, Tiruvannamalai receives a fixed subsidy of Rs 492 a year for the middle school department of the high school at Tiruvannamalai. This subsidy was fixed for the school when it was a middle school. In G.O. No. 1934 L & M. dated 14-10-22 the Government approved the action of the Council in having opened forms IV & V in its secondary school on the understanding that the extra expenditure should be borne by the Council from its own funds. Thus the subsidy of Rs 492 which is paid at present to the school is only towards the cost of maintenance of the middle school department. The Municipal Council has now applied that if subsidy might be raised to Rs Rs 4000/-. The Director of Public Instruction does not recommend it, as the financial condition of the Municipality as evidenced by its Administration Report for 1923-24 has improved, since. It has been submitted for orders whether the financial position of the Municipality may be examined in L.S.G. now to ascertain whether it is in need of assistance in maintaining the high school. The answer to this clause may be :-

" An application has been received from the Municipal Council, Tiruvannamalai for an increase to raising the subsidy paid to it for the maintenance of ~~the~~ ^{the} high school. It is under consideration "

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The Council also desires that a portion of the cost of the main building ^{already constructed} amounting to Rs 1828/ in the accounts of 1917, after the Government had met 2/3 of the net expenditure, should now be paid to the municipality after this lapse of time. The Director of Public Instruction does not recommend either. The question is being dealt with separately.
