Sir,

In submitting herewith letter No. 2262, dated 5th August 1925 of the President, Taluk Board, Chidambaram together with a proposition statement for revision of the Board Girls' Schools, Porto Novo, I have the honour to state that under G.O. No. 1132, Law (Education) dated 23rd September 1922, the Government Muhammadan and Hindu Girls' Schools at Porto Novo were transferred to the management of the Taluk Board, Chidambaram and a subsidy of Rs 42 4162 is being paid for their maintenance.

2. On account of the continued low strength and attendance in the Muhammadan Girls' School, the President, Taluk Board Chidambaram proposes to abolish the last Assistant's post on Rs 22½ (19½ plus capitation allowance 3) in the school

and to utilise the savings towards the cost of revision of the salaries of teachers in both schools as shown in the proposition statement. The Inspectress of Girls' Schools of the Circle supports the proposed revision.

3. The Hindu Girls' School has on its staff six teachers including the headmaster while there are four teachers including the headmistress in the Muhammadan Girls' School. The particulars of strength and attendance in respect of the Muhammadan Girls' School do not justify the employment of four teachers. As the teachers in Government Girls' Schools transferred to the control of the Taluk Boards have no chances of transfer and promotion and as the staff of the Hindu Girls' School is doing good work a revised scale is proposed by the Taluk Board. The scale of pay proposed is however less than that allowed by Government for teachers in their schools. In these circumstances the abolition of the last Assistant's post in the Muhammadan Girls' School is recommended and the savings thus accrued may be utilised for the proposed revision of salaries. No extra cost is involved in the proposal.

4. In respect of the II Assistant's post of the Muhammadan Girls' School the Taluk Board proposed to reduce the scale from Rs 25-8-0 to Rs 25/- This is with a view ^{bring it to} a round sum. The present incumbent of the post is reported to be a permanent teacher and ^{so} the reduction of Rs 0-8-0 proposed will affect her pension. The proposal in this one respect, therefore is not supported and the pay of this teacher may remain unaltered.
