Sir,

I have the honour, by direction, to inform you that, consequent on the leave for a period of six months granted to Dr. John Matthai, Professor of Indian Economics, who is now away on deputation with the Government of India (Commerce Department) as a member of the Tariff Board, the Syndicate approved of the recommendation of the Professor that M.R.Ry. T.K. Duraiswami Aiyar Avl., Assistant Professor should act as Professor on an allowance of Rs.150/- per mensem during his absence in addition to his present salary of Rs.500/- with effect from the 19th June, 1925. 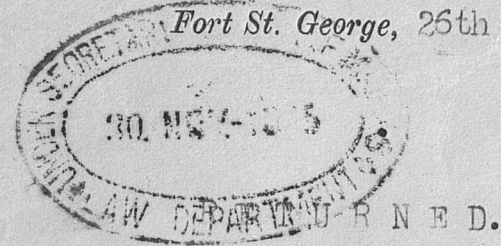

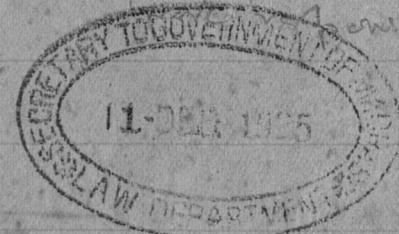

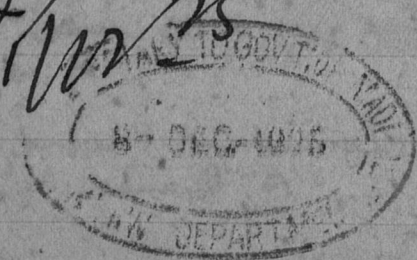
