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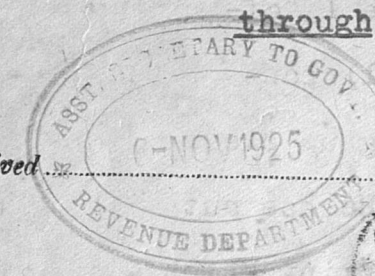

Letter from A.R. Mac Ewen Esquire, M.A., I.C.S., Special Settlement Officer, Party No. IV, Tinnevely, - Ramnad, Madura and Trichinopoly, R.O.C.No. 706/L 25, dated 21st October 1925.

There is a permanent vacancy in the grade of Head classifier in this party caused by the death of M.R.Ry., R. Natesam Pillai on 12-9-'25 and I propose to confirm in it M.R.Ry., M.P. Unnikrishna Menon who is a permanent classifier on Rs.47/- in the scale of Rs. 35-1 1/2-50-1-60, drawing Rs.100/- on the temporary

establishment

establishment. He is, however, not qualified by the general Educational Test prescribed in Article 1 of the Public Service Notification, but he is well conversant with English and is capable of putting up clear and intelligible reports in that language. He has put in a total service of 19 years and 5 months during which he has done good work both in office and in the field. He has done duty as Superintendent of the Branch office at Jayankondacholapuram since 1-12-'22 and he saw through the heavy rush of work at the time of Kadarambam introduction. There are passed men in the party - holding permanent posts in the grade of clerk or classifier, but I have selected M.R.Ry., M.P. Unnikrishna Menon for the existing vacancy, as he has preferential claim to it from the point of view of service and merit, which I do not think it proper to overlook on the mere ground that he does not possess the formal qualifications of the general Educational Test.

I have the honour therefore to request that the Board may be pleased to obtain the sanction of Government for the permanent exemption of M.R.Ry., M.P. Unnikrishna Menon from the provision of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification so as to enable him to hold the post of Head Classifier on Rs.60/- to start with and to draw the annual increments in that post up to Rs.80/- which is the maximum pay thereof.

An application in the prescribed form is enclosed.

The permanent pay of the clerk who is recommended for exemption is Rs. 47 in the scale of Rs. 35-60, but he draws Rs. 100 on the temporary establishment. He is now recommended for ~~exemption~~ promotion ~~for~~ to a permanent post on Rs. 60-80. In another case H.M. ~~2~~ ^{C2} and ~~C1~~ noted that application for promotion to the higher grade should be considered only after the clerk reaches the top of the lower grade scale. It is for orders whether the Board's recommendation in this case may be accepted. If so, the draft below is for approval.

The case referred to at A on the previous page is submitted (Slip F). It was therein proposed to promote a camp clerk and typist to the upper division of the clerical service. It was thought that H. M.'s orders in that case referred generally to the promotion of exempted candidates from a lower to a higher scale of pay.

Please see the Hon'ble the Finance Member's note dated 7-10-25 on page 6 of the above G.O. where the reaching of the top of the lower grade scale is specifically mentioned as a condition for granting exemption ~~for~~ higher scale. It is for orders whether in future a differentiation should be made between cases of promotion to posts which carry greater responsibility and to those which do not involve any large change in the quality of work.
