Sir,

The Syndicate at its meeting held on the 7th instant considered G.O. No.1691, Law (Education) dated 30th September 1925 ordering a distribution of the 250 copies of Part I of Volume I of the Tamil Lexicon supplied by the University in return for the surrender to the University of the copyright in the same. The Syndicate notes that instructions have been issued to the Superintendent, Government Press, for stocking in the Press one hundred and thirty copies for sale to the public. With reference to this arrangement I am directed to inform the Government that, in the opinion of the Syndicate, it is not desirable that the Government should offer for sale copies of the Tamil Lexicon as this procedure would interfere with the sale by the University of the volumes in its possession, and to request that, in the light of the above explanation, the Government will be pleased to either issue free of cost all available copies of the Lexicon to suitable institutions etc., or keep any balance in reserve.

Subject Sale of copies of the Tamil Lexicon.

As pointed out by the University the sale by Govt of copies of the Tamil Lexicon will interfere with the sale by the University of the volume in its possession, but this cannot be helped. The Syndicate agreed to supply 250 copies to the Government free of cost in return for the surrender of the copyright to the University and it is ^{open} left to the Govt to dispose of these copies in the manner they consider best.
