Sir,

I have the honour to submit below a scheme for
the introduction of weaving in the Board Elementary School,
Tanur, under the Ponnani Taluk Board.

2. Instruction is proposed to be given to about
36 pupils belonging to Standards IV & V in 5 Sections, each
section receiving a day's instruction per week.

3. The scheme, which has been scrutinized by the
Adviser, is estimated to cost Rs.1,635/- of which Rs.440/- is
for recurring and Rs.1,195 is non-recurring charges as per
details noted in the margin.
