In accordance with rule 17 of the Madras Educational Rules there should be a teacher for every form or class and for every section of form or class in addition to the head master (excluding pandits, munshis etc). The M.D.C may be referred to this rule.

Clause (c). No information is available in this office. The D.P.I may be requested to offer his remarks on this clause.
Clause (d).

According to rule 18 of the Educational Rules a class or section of a class should not have more than 40 pupils on the rolls. If more pupils are admitted the class should be divided into sections and additional teachers appointed. The attention of the hon. members may be invited to this rule.

The Board High School, Penukonda has nine sections and there are 10 assistants besides the headmaster, Pandits, etc. The sanctioned staff includes three high school assistants, besides the headmaster. The staff is adequate.

There are now 17 sections in the Municipal High School, Anantapur, and including the two temporary assistants sanctioned in G.O.No.3313 L & M., Mis., dated 14-9-1925 there are 17 assistants besides the headmaster, pandits, etc. The strength of the staff of the High School department was found to be insufficient prior to the sanction of the two temporary assistants referred to above as two additional sections were opened in the current year. At present the staff is adequate.

The following reply is suggested to class (c);
'The staff of Penukonda is adequate and in the case of Anantapur additional staff were ~~was~~ sanctioned for additional sections this year.'
