Sir,

I have the honour to state that S.Narasinga Rao permanent Headmaster, Government Girls School, Tadpatri which was transferred to the management of the Municipal Council, Tadpatri under G.O.No.1132 Law(Education) dated 23-9-22 was working in the Government Girls School, Hindupur at the time of its transfer to the Municipal Council, Hindupur on 1-9-22. The teacher was transferred by the Chairman as a temporary measure on 1-8-24 to the Municipal Hindu Boys School which was not at the time and had not been under Government control. He worked there till 29-1-25 and was reverted to the Municipal Girls School(formerly under Government) on 30-1-25 as the transfer

transfer of the teacher to the boys school which was not under Government control was objected to by the Assistant Examiner of Local Fund Accounts who pointed out that the pensionary rights of the teacher would be affected.

2. As the teacher was transferred along with the school to the municipality, his services count for pension under article 804 of the Civil Service Regulation. The period (1-8-24 to 30-1-25) during which the teacher was employed in the Boys school has therefore to be treated as duty on foreign service. The Chairman, Municipal Council, Hindupur reports that the council has agreed to bear the pensionary contribution on behalf of the teacher for the period (vide) copy of his letter enclosed. I recommend that in these circumstances, the teachers service may be considered to have been lent to the Municipal Council, Hindupur for the period from 1-8-24 to 30-1-25.

2. The service of the teacher in the Hindupur Girls' School, prior to 1-8-1924 counts for pension from general revenues under article 804 Civil Service Regulations. During such service he retains a claim to pension only from Government on final retirement and for all other purposes he is a municipal servant entitled to pay and leave salary from municipal funds. His employment during the period from 1-8-1924 to 30-1-1925 under the Municipal Hindu Boys' School Hindupur, which had never been under Government control, would therefore constitute an interruption in his qualifying service for pension, which may be condoned by Government under article 422 of the Civil Service Regulations.

3. The proposal to treat the period from 1-8-1924 to 30-1-1925 as foreign service

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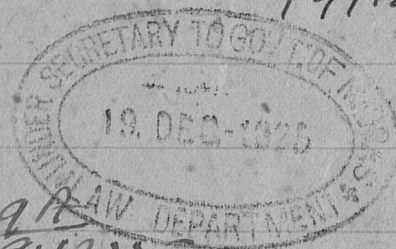
