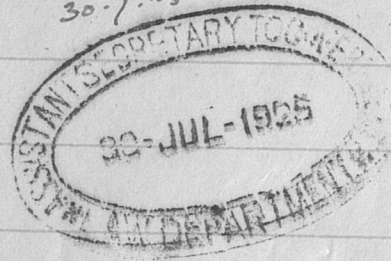

On receipt of ~~the~~ G.O. No.164, Law (Education), dated the 4th February 1925, all unpassed clerks in this department who have not been specifically exempted from the provisions of Article 1 of the Public Service Notifications have, with effect from the 1st March 1925, been allowed only the minimum pay admissible to clerks, i.e., Rs.35/- in the mufassal and Rs.40/- in Madras city. I have, however, called for a list of all such unpassed clerks with a view to considering the question of their exemption from the examination rules in deserving cases, with reference to paragraph 4 of the G.O. quoted above.
