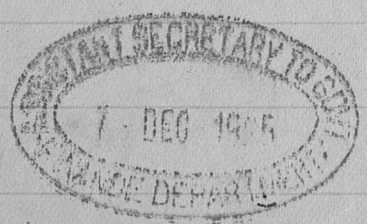

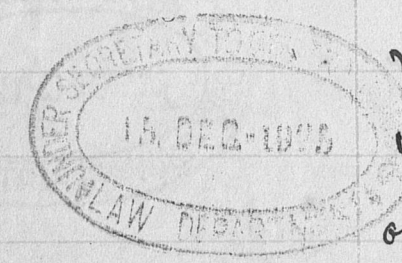

With reference to the Finance note above it is submitted that there is no proper comparison between the Agricultural department and the Educational department. While the former is comparatively a small one with one college and certain <sup>highly paid officers</sup> ~~highly paid officers~~ the latter is a big one with many colleges <sup>and a large number of professors who may</sup> ~~and a large number of professors who may~~ It will be in the interests of the Educational department that some of the professors keep themselves in touch with the latest developments in science. It may also be noted that a similar suggestion was made by Finance in connection with the proposal to depute eight officers to attend the Science Congress at



Bangalore in January 1924 that finally the Director's recommendation was approved - go. no. 13 L.E. & 4.1.24. Similarly <sup>the deputations</sup> 5 officers selected by the D.I.D. to attend the Mathematical Conference at Rome in April 1924 was approved by the Govt after discussion on the question of a reduction in the number of officers.
