Sir,

In G.O.No. 1164 L.S.M. dated 3-10-22 the Government ordered the discontinuance of capitation allowance from 1-4-23 and to compensate this loss for that year the pay of the teachers was recommended to be enhanced suitably so that the teachers may not become losers but nothing was said in the above G.O. for the payment of capitation allowance earned during 22-23 and payable in 23-24. The Council in Resolution No.15. dated 25-3-24 was pleased to sanction a remuneration of Rs. 36 per teacher for 22-23 in lieu of the capitation allowance. This payment has been objected to by the auditor and a copy of the



objection is enclosed. The payment cannot be said to be a duplication as it relates to 22-23 and not to 23-24 from which year the pay of the teachers has been enhanced.

2) Reference is made to para 3 of G.O.No. 1508 Law-Education dated 30-10-23 in the objection. The reasons for stopping the payment of capitation allowance payable in 23-24 are not given in it. The objection taken by the auditor cannot therefore be a valid one.

3). It is therefore requested that the Government will be pleased to remove the objection taken or approve the action of the Council in the payment of the remuneration to the teachers.

Extract of para 41. of the audit report for the period 1-1-24 to 31-3-24.

Vr. 732 for Rs. 900-4-1 being the remuneration paid to the elementary school teachers in view of capitation allowance for the year 22-23. as per Council Resolution No.15. dated 25-3-24. Under G.O.No. 1164 dated 3-10-22 compensation for the loss of capitation allowance is payable only with effect from 1-4-23. In para (iii) of the elementary education budget approved in G.O.No. 1508 dated 30-10-23 for the year 23-24 it was clearly stated that the allowance or compensation in question earned in 22-23 and payable in 23-24 need not be paid. The payment of the allowance being thus quite contrary to the express orders of Government, the sum of Rs. 900-4-1 should be recovered.

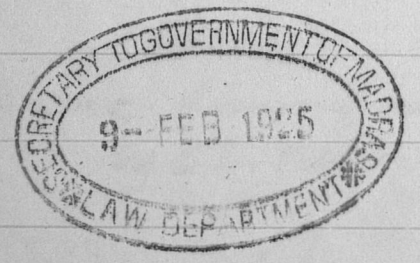

IV In G.O. No. 1508 L.D. 30.10.23 the Municipal Council, Siruvaimamalai, was expressly told that the Capitulation allowance earned in 1922-23 & payable in 1923-24 need not be paid and that the provision entered in the budget for the purpose should be deleted. In spite of these orders, the Council resolved on a subsequent date (25-3-24) to sanction a remuneration of Rs 36 per teacher for 1922-23 in lieu of the capitulation allowance. The teachers have also had their pay revised to compensate them of the loss of capitulation allowance. ~~It is stated that the Council has decided to pay the allowance to the teachers from the fund of the Council.~~

2 The Council's decision was no doubt based on considerations of equity and justice and, as the amount has already been paid, it does not appear desirable to order its recovery from the poor teachers. There is already considerable public agitation on the subject. The Council's action may be approved as a special case.
