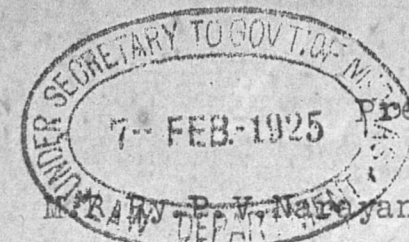

I have the honour to request you to move the Government for a reconsideration of their orders regarding the grant - of halting allowance to the Non-Official members of the ---- council.

G.O.1647 dated 17-11-21 disallows halting allowance. - (C)
But when this G.O. was passed the rates of Travelling Allowance granted to members then in force were double second --- class fares for railway journeys and the corresponding rates for road and canal journeys. Under such conditions it was equitable that separate halting allowances were not paid. -- But subsequent to this G.O., the rates of T.A. were reduced by the Government. Vide G.O. 33 dated 10-1-22. Single fares - (B) especially when they are of the second class do not leave -- any margin to cover incidental expenditure such as the ----- Jutaka hire at the stations and in the town, the cooly charges at the railway stations, the hotel charges in the town etc. -

So far as my knowledge goes the Government T.A. rules -- are quite clear on the point. They contemplate halting and - touring allowances besides daily batta when single fares are sanctioned. So the member gets allowance to cover all the - expenses incidental to the journey and the halt. This ----- difficulty is increased when the member is to attend a sub-committee meeting of the council. He is to stay for a day or two, is to run to the place of business from his residence or quarters and is thus made to meet extra charges.

Unless the Government reconsiders this question of halting allowance, members are forced to pay from their pocket for the purpose of taking part in the deliberations of the council
