Salary of the Headmaster, Central High School, Mercara.

SIR,

I am directed to invite a reference to the Proceedings of the Government of Madras, Law (Education) Department No. R.247, dated the 30th April 1923, sanctioning the appointment of M.R.Ry.Panje Mangesha Rao Avargal, as acting Headmaster, Central High School, Mercara, and permitting him to draw a salary of Rs.350 per mensem, with effect from the 1st April 1923.

2. As Mr. Mangesha Rao completed a year's service in his acting appointment on the 31st March 1924 and has discharged his duties satisfactorily, the Chief Commissioner considers that he should be given an increment of Rs.25 per mensem from the 1st April 1924. The question of increments to Mr. Mangesha Rao was referred to the Director of Public Instruction, Madras, in October 1923, and that officer, after consulting the Accountant General, Madras, has now said that the Government of Madras may be moved in the matter. I am, therefore, to request that the pay of Mr. Mangesha Rao may be fixed at Rs.375 from the 1st April 1924 to the 31st March 1925. As Mr. Mangesha Rao will have completed a further year's service on the 1st April 1925, I am to take this opportunity to request sanction at the same time to the grant of pay to him at Rs.400 per mensem from that date.

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3. The Accountant General, Madras, has, in a letter to the Director of Public Instruction, Madras, suggested the rate of Rs.400 in lieu of Rs.375 on the ground that it is the minimum rate of pay in the scale sanctioned for officers of the Indian Educational Service, and that there is no stage at Rs.375 in that scale. But it will be seen from the correspondence ending with Mr. Moore's letter No. 170 A., dated the 30th January 1923, that it is proposed to remove the post of Headmaster, Central High School, Mercara, from the Indian Educational Service to the Madras Educational Service. It is, therefore, undesirable to regulate the pay of Mr. Mangesha Rao by the scale of pay of the officers of the Indian Educational Service. Fundamental Rule 35 authorises local Governments to fix the pay of officiating Government servants at an amount less than that admissible under the rules.

4. As this matter has already been delayed for some considerable time by correspondence with the Director of Public Instruction and the Accountant General, Madras, the Chief Commissioner will be obliged if the sanction of the Government of Madras can be communicated to him at a very early date.
