Under G.O.No.930 Educational dated 18-10-12 Miss.Bower, Headmistress, Queen Mary's High School for Indian Girls, Vizagapatam was living rent free in a portion of the school building till 21-11-24 when she was relieved from the post to join her officiating appointment as Inspectress of Girls Schools, Southern Circle. The Accountant General, Madras has objected to the occupation by the headmistress of the school of rent free quarters. I thereupon invited his attention to the G.O quoted above but he considers that the concession enjoyed by the headmistress under the

above

(A) above G.O cannot be continued on the ground that the headmistress is not one of the officers who have been allowed rent free quarters in G.O.No.458 Law(Education) dated 26-3-24.

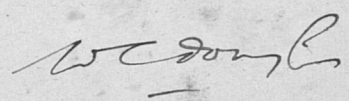
2. I beg to submit that as there is no reference whatever to the headmistress in question in G.O.No. 458 Law(Education) dated 26-3-24 Miss.Bower continued to live in the school free of rent. I have now however, in the light of the Accountant Generals objection issued orders to the effect that Miss Bowers' successor will be charged rent for her quarters in future.

3. I request that in the circumstances stated above Government may be pleased to waive the objection raised by the Accountant General in respect of Miss. Bowers' occupation of rent free quarters in the Queen Mary's High School for Indian Girls, Vizagapatam.

Refce. Your T.M. dated 7-1-25 regarding the date from which Miss E.M. Bower was in occupation of the quarters in the premises of the Queen Mary's High School, Vizagapatam.

Miss Bower reports that she was in occupation of the quarters from 21st January 1921 to the end of August 1923 when she handed over charge to Miss Gray. She returned to Vizagapatam and again took charge as Headmistress on 9-5-1924, the date on which the school closed for the summer vacation but she went into residence only 2 or 3 days before the school re-opened which was about 23-6-1924 and remained there till 20-11-1924 when she again handed over charge to Miss Gray.

Note:- When the question of the continuation of rent-free quarters

for the officers of the Ed. Dept. was examined with refer. to the Retirement -
ment Committee's recommendations were examined last year the D.P.D. did not bring the case of this officer to the notice of Govt. Had it been ^{brought to notice} the order in Paragraph 1(ii) of G.O. No. 458 Ed., d/26th March 1924 would apply to this officer. In other words the concession of rent-free quarters would have been continued to this officer, but withdrawn from her successors in office and that is what the Director recommends now. The proposed remission of rent is personal to Miss Bower. Draft may go to Finance for acceptance.

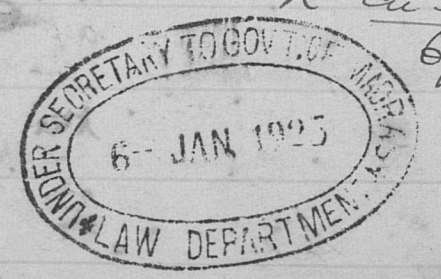

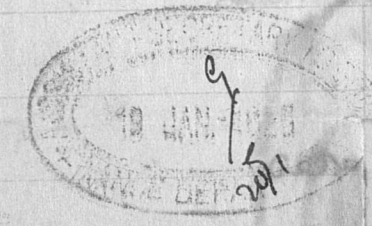

With reference to the presumption of the Finance Deptt at page 2 ante that Miss Bower was in occupation of free quarters from a date prior to 26-3-1924 attention is invited to the telephonic message from the D.P.I. It will be seen therefrom that the officer was in continuous occupation of the quarters in question ^{from} 21-1-1921 to the end of August 1923 and again from 20-6-1924 to 20-11-1924. Technically she ^{will not} come under G.O. No. 458 Law (Education), dated 26-3-1924 as she ^{was} in occupation of the quarters at the time the orders were issued. But as the rent she has to refund is only for that for five months (from 20-6-24 to 20-11-1924) the draft order on page 1 ante may be issued. The Finance Department may be requested to ^{say} whether they have any objection to this.
