High Court of Judicature, Madras.

Sir,

The High Court, in Order Dis. No. 859/1923 dated 3-5-1923, communicated copy of letter No. R. 245, Law, Education dated 27-4-1923, of the Acting Secretary to the Government of Madras to the effect that M.S. Syed Abdul Kadir Sahib, Clerk, District Court, East Tanjore, was permanently exempted by Government from the provisions of article (1) of the Public Service Notification in order that he might hold posts in the Judicial Department on a pay not exceeding Rs. 60/- per mensem.

(D) In G.O.No. 722, Law (Education) dated 13-6-1922 it is laid down that persons already exempted may rise up to Rs. 50/- in the scale of Rs. 35-60, where there will be an efficiency bar and to pass it, the orders of the head of the department would suffice.

In this Court's letter No. 696, dated 5-2-1923, the claims of M.S. Syed Abdul Kadir Sahib were specially brought to the notice of the High Court for obtaining the orders of the Government permanently exempting him to hold the post of a Deputy Nazir which is in the scale of Rs. 60-4-80, a different scale.

On the High Court's recommendation the Government viewing his case very favourably passed orders granting him permanent exemption, as referred to in para 1 above.

It is in the purview of the High Court to grant increments to him up to Rs. 60/- in the scale of Rs. 35-60 and his case had specially to be taken to Government for exemption only to hold posts carrying a pay of Rs. 60-4-80. I request that in these circumstances the Government may be moved to grant him exemption to hold the posts of Deputy Nazir or Superintendent of Copyists on

From 1-3-1924, he has been holding the post of Superintendent of Copyists of this Court drawing Rs. 40 plus 12, which has now been brought in the scale of - - Rs. 60-4-80. He has acquitted himself very well in his work.
