Sir,

I have the honour to report that the management of the St.Christopers Training College, Madras, actually incurred during the year 1923 an expenditure to the extent of Rs.4869 towards the cost of certain articles of furniture and books purchased for the use of the college which was newly opened in July 1923 and affiliated to the University of Madras in G.O.No. 1289 dated 13-9-1923.6wing to the embargo placed in respect of applications for grants for furniture and books

(D) books vide G.O.No.572 Law(Education) dated 10-5-22 which was removed in G.O.No.388 Mis Law(Education) (A) dated 14-3-1924, the management was prevented from applying for grant-in-aid for the above purpose then and there. The institution having been newly started necessitating a heavy expenditure, I request that you will be pleased to obtain the sanction of Government to the payment of a half grant of Rs.2435 which the management has now applied for.

2. If the above recommendation is approved, the expenditure can be met from the provision of Rs.25000/- under "31 A(a)(iv) Education-University-non Government Professional colleges- subsidy" in the Budget Estimate for 1924-25.

Grant for equipment

Under the rules in chapter IX of the Grant in Aid Code applications for grants for equipment should be submitted to the D.P.I and grants should not be given for articles regarding which the Director has not been consulted and for which aid has not been promised previously to purchase or manufacture. On account of financial stringency, the Govt. decided in G.O.No.572, dated 10-5-1922, not to entertain applications for grants for equipment other than that for science subjects. This restriction was removed only in March last. The D.P.I now recommends a grant for articles of furniture and books purchased by the St. --- Christopher's Training College in 1923. As the articles were not purchased with the previous sanction of the department, no grant is ^{ordinarily} admissible in this case. But the D.P.I states that it was owing to the embargo placed by Government in respect of grants for furniture ~~and~~ books etc, that previous sanction was not applied for. It is for orders whether the grant may be sanctioned as a special case. It is possible that there may be other similar cases in which also a similar concession may have to be allowed. If the D.P.I's proposal is accepted, the draft below is for approval.

We have no idea as to our total liability in this respect will come up to. There have actually been some cases in which the management had made their own arrangements to meet the full cost of the equipment during the period.
