I have the honour to report that the Bursar, Madras Christian College, ordered in November 1923 certain non-Indian periodicals at a cost of Rs.178, as they were required for the college use. Owing to the embargo placed ~~in respect of~~ ^{on} applications for grants for books and furniture, vide G.O.No.572 Law(Education) dated 10-5-22, which was removed only in 1924-vide G.O.No.388 Mis Law(Education) 14-3-24, the management was prevented at the moment from applying for grant-in-aid for the above purpose. The Bursar of the Madras Christian College now applies for a half

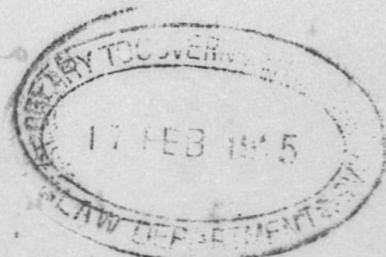

With reference to M2's order on 9.2.25, it is submitted that it has been reported by the D.P.O. that the expenditure in the case of the St. Christopher's training college, Madras, can be met from the provision made for "grants to Professional colleges" vide cf. in the linked file - and this may be sanctioned. A draft order has accordingly been put up in the linked file.

As regards the expenditure in the case of the Madras Christian college dealt with in this file, it is not known whether it can be met from ^(savings in) the allotment under "Professional colleges"; moreover, this will involve a reappropriation from the head "Professional colleges" to the head "Aids colleges" which requires the sanction of the Finance Dept. It would therefore seem preferable in this case to include the expenditure in the approved list and leave the D.P.O. to pay the sum when funds are available.
