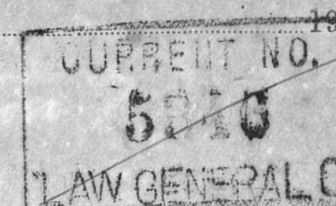

An Adi-Dravida/by name Kuppusami reported to be of 14 years of age was put up before the Joint Magistrate Negapatam for having stolen a kid-an offence under Section 379 I.P.C. The Joint Magistrate found him guilty and on 26th June 1924 sentenced him to suffer Rigorous Imprisonment for 6 months and in lieu thereof ordered him to be detained in the Reformatory school for 4 years. I enclose the connected records of the case C.C.94/24 on the file of the Sub Divisional Magistrate Negapatam. It is seen from the records that the Sub Divisional Magistrate found that the father of the accused refused to look after him and that the accused had neither a fixed abode

fixed abode nor fixed occupation. The accused was accordingly sent to the Reformatory school at Chingleput and delivered to the custody of the Superintendent on 28th June 1924.

2. The Joint Magistrate Negapatam reports that some time after, one Chinnan Samban paternal Grand father of the accused represented to him that he would take care of the accused if handed over to him. He considers that the petitioner is sincere in his representations and recommends that the accused may be restored to him. I also enclose a copy of his report. (below)

3. I accordingly request that the Government may be pleased to order the discharge of the juvenile from the Reformatory School under Sec.14(a) of the Act.

Criminal cases-Joint Magistrate's Court-Negapatam C.C.94/24
prisoner sent to Reformatory School-application for release.

The Nagore police charge sheeted one Kuppusami-an adi-dravida boy of 14 years for an offence under section 379 I.P.C. for having stolen a kid on 16-6-24. The accused was found guilty and was directed to be sent to the Reformatory School at Chingle put to be detained there for a period of 4 years as it was then brought to my notice that the accused had neither fixed abode nor fixed occupation and that his father neglected to look after the boy having married another wife. After pronouncing judgment, one Chinnan Samban, paternal grand-father of the accused appeared before me and represented that he would take particular care of the boy and wanted that the boy might be handed over to him. As my judgment was already pronounced and the boy sent to jail, I could not at once grant the request of the petitioner. I subsequently made enquiries about the representations of the petitioner and consider that the petitioner is sincere in his representations and the boy might be safely entrusted to his care and custody. I therefore request that the Local Government may be moved to release the boy and hand over the boy to the custody of the petitioner-his paternal grand-father.

With reference to Government Endorsement 2645 B-1 dated 24-9-24 referring for remarks the papers relating to the discharge from the Reformatory school Chingleput of the Adi vradia boy kuppaswamy under section 14(a) of the Reformatory Schools Act, I have the honour to state that ~~the~~ boy was admitted into the school on 28-6-24 and that he has not misconducted himself since then. The Superintendent of the school, whom I consulted in the matter, reports however that the boy is a very shifty sort of character, and much in need of proper training and supervision. He seems to have

have told the Superintendent that he was, at the time of his conviction residing and having his food in the house of his grandfather Chinnan Samban and I think that the latter was not wholly irresponsible for the boys training and conduct. In these circumstances it is doubtful if the grandfather may be considered to be a fit person to look after the boy, after discharge. I recommend, therefore, that before the boy is discharged, his grandfather might be required to furnish such security or surety for the boys future conduct as the District Magistrate might deem fit
